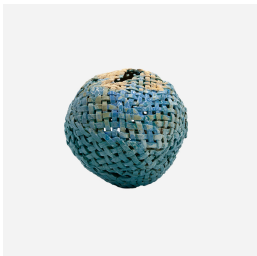
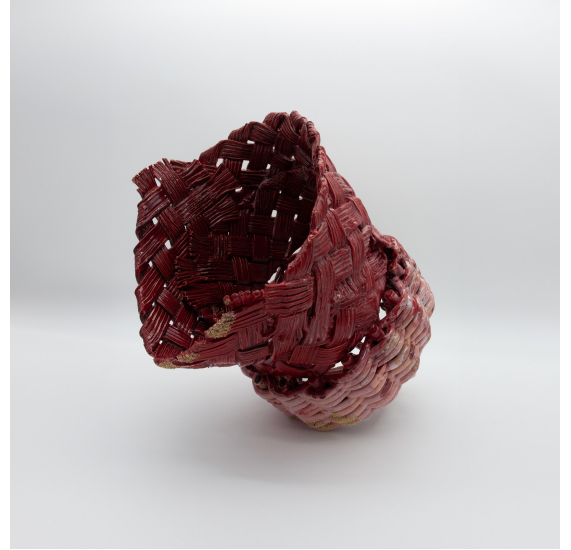


ANINA MAJOR
