John Hogan is a Seattle-based glass artist known for his work, which encompasses both functional objects and fine art sculpture and is consistent in its exploration of refracted light. Drawing influences from a wide range of sources - from physics to molecular gastronomy - Hogan's sculptures evoke an otherworldly quality, morphing simple, recognizable forms into complex, inexpressible objects.





































































































