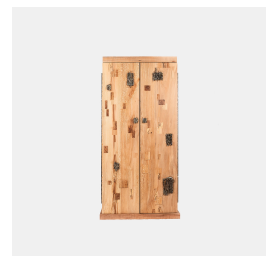
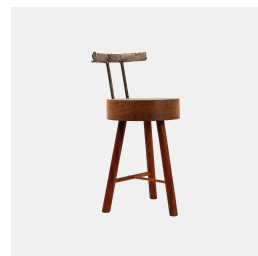
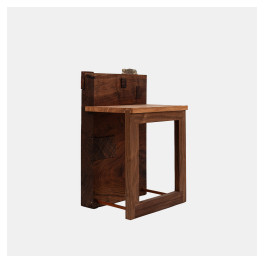
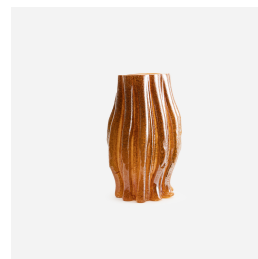
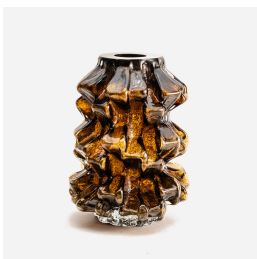


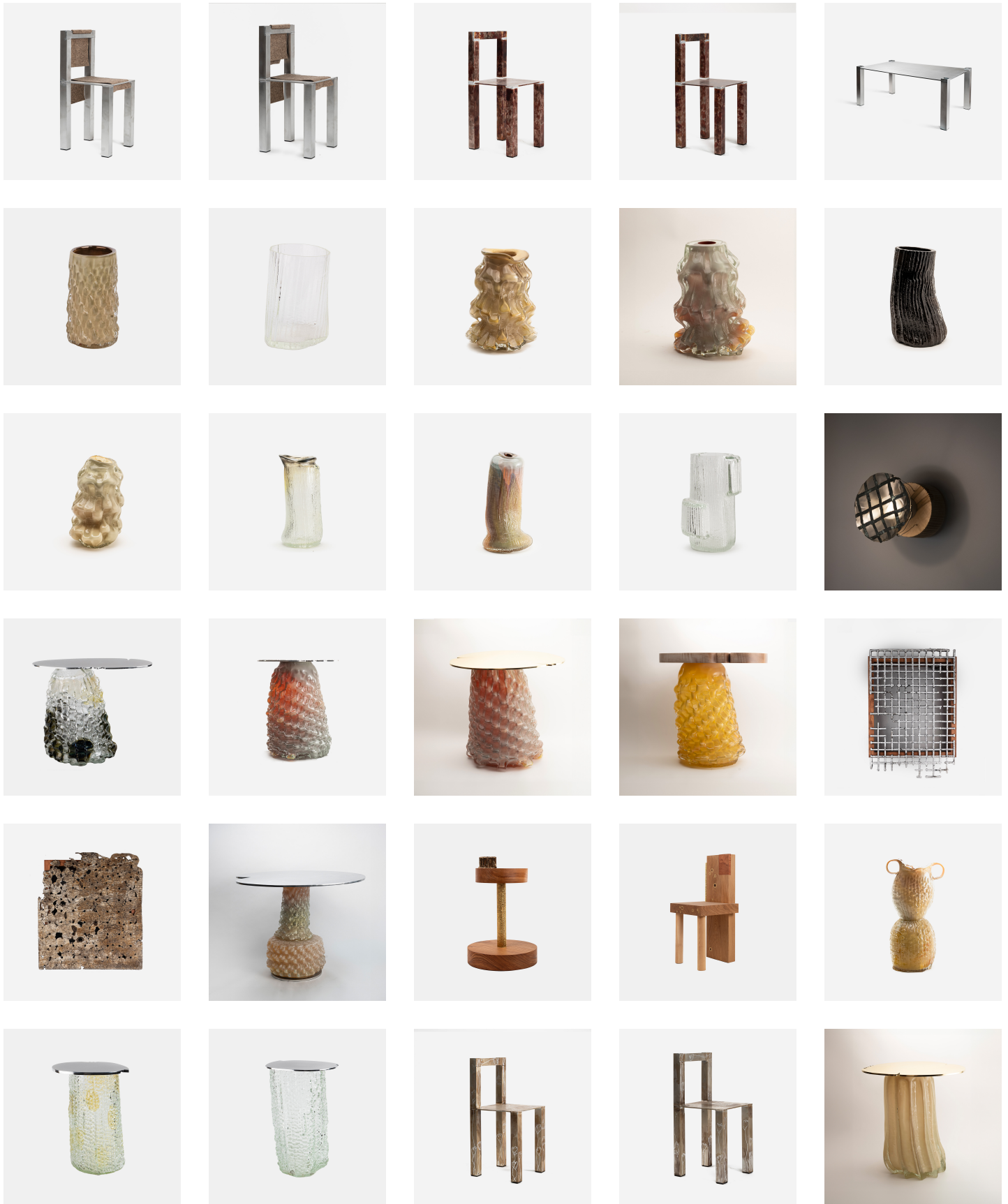
RAFI AJL

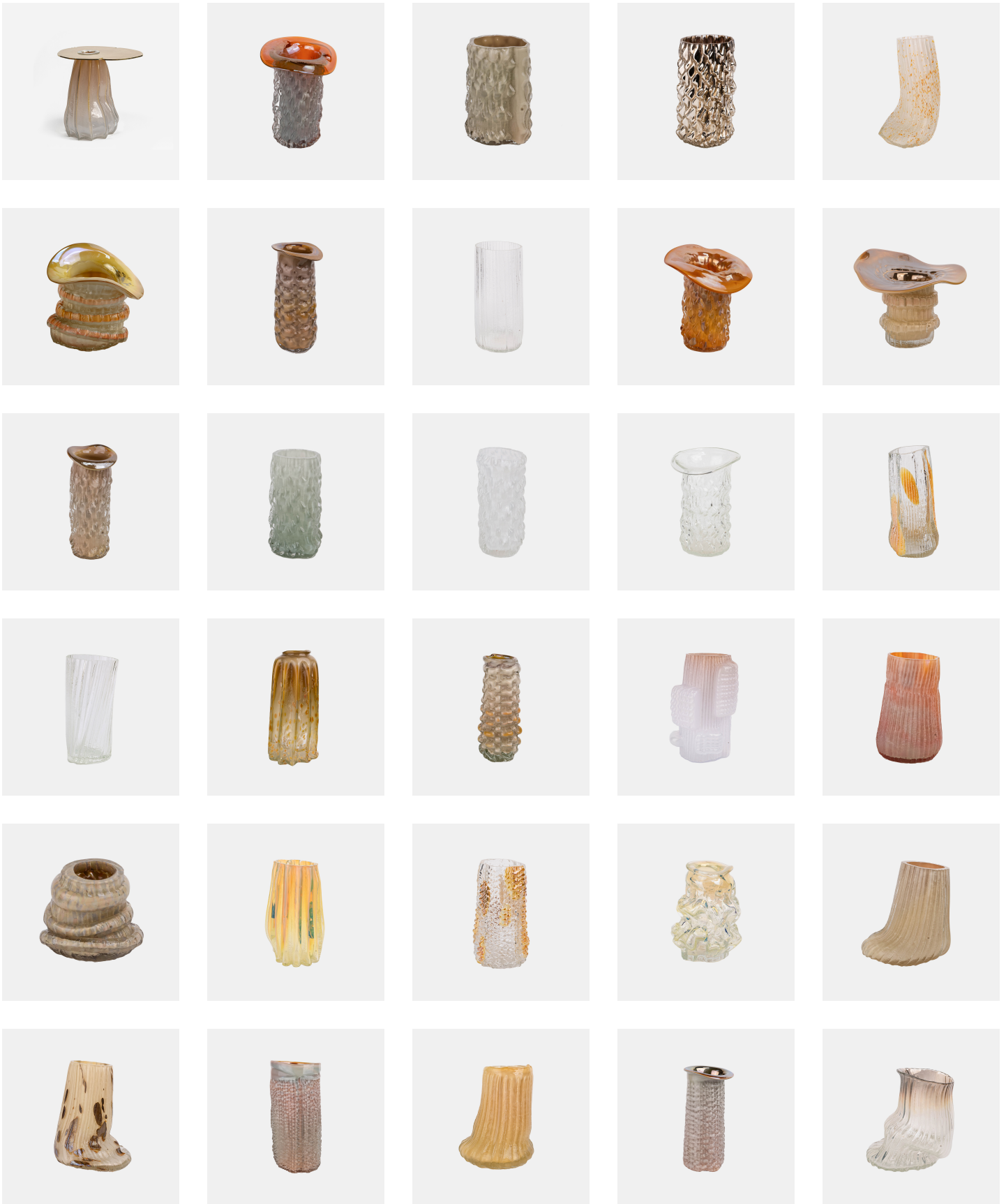
Ajl's approach is also deeply rooted in post-structuralist critical theory, which emphasizes that the process is never terminal but boundless and full of play.



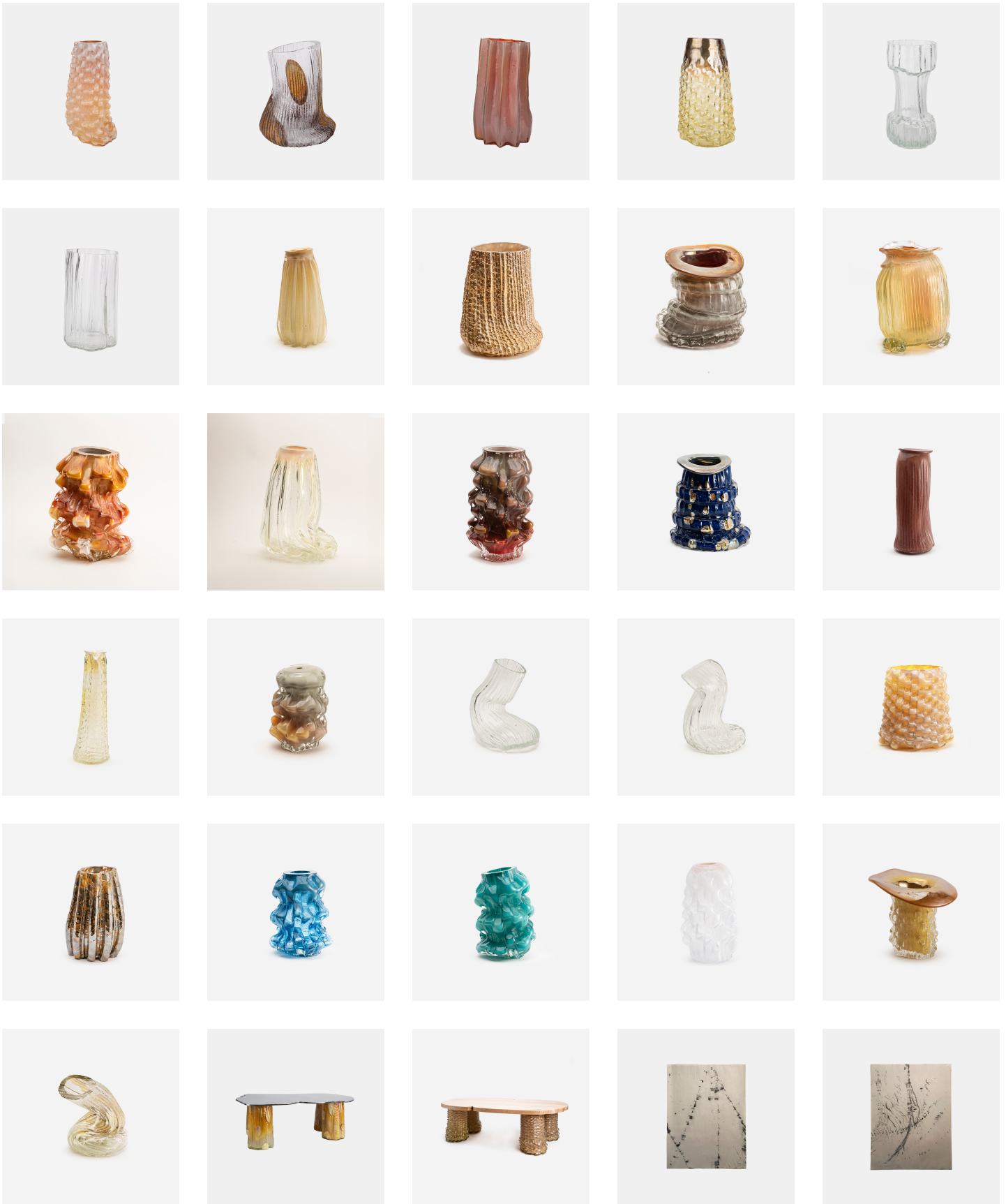

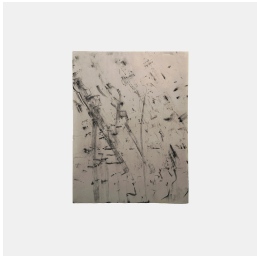
