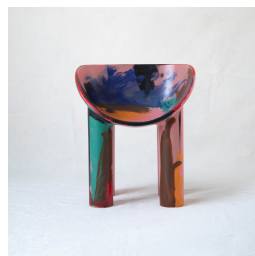
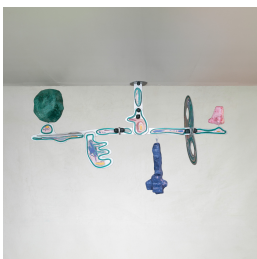


TOOGOOD
